- Deliver 2 research seminars for faculty
- Deliver 1 research seminar for PhD students
- Contribute to research grant proposal development, with a particular focus on cross-border and European funding opportunities

- Data Driven Decision Making course for the *Programme Grande École (PGE)*
 - duration: 2.5 hours
- AI Seminar for MSc in Business Analytics for the *MSc in Sustainability Transformations*
 - duration: 5 hours
- AI Seminar for MSc in Artificial Intelligence for Business for the *Global Bachelor of Business Administration (GBBA)*
 - duration: 5 hours
